it in the list lately sent you?  
If so it is a mistake as I have  
no entries in my books against  
crediting the bond of W.  
Poff Jr. No 12. T<sup>l</sup> W<sup>th</sup> M<sup>th</sup> L<sup>th</sup> the  
amount was for returned to this  
office on Non Resident's Rolls  
for vs William Poff the younger  
Lot No 12. T<sup>l</sup> Cen W<sup>th</sup> M<sup>th</sup> Lake 200 ac  
for 1857.

9/2 the same specification  
for 1852<sup>2/2</sup> & 1853<sup>1/2</sup> which with  
the Statute increase of 100p makes  
up £3. 1. 1 including Sheriff's fees

I find by referring to the letter  
of the Clerk Westmeath Dec 16<sup>th</sup>  
1859 stating the action the Council  
had taken in regard to list of  
lands in arrears for Taxes &  
which might be sold, that while  
they cancelled several lots, that  
the above lot is on list of those  
for which they wanted to find  
out the years for which the taxes  
were due, and which was furnished  
by me but no subsequent notice  
was taken of the matter so that  
the lot was advertised with the  
usual publicity of 3 months  
notice, was put up for sale  
and fifty acres of it sold  
to Supt Mallock on the

2<sup>d</sup> May 1860, The year  
passed over and no offer  
to redeem it during the time  
when the judge called and got  
Certificates on which he got  
Sheriff's deed, The Ralls on  
which the taxes are, are made  
up by Abel Beach & Son  
to as to their correctness before  
John Tucker Reevs there is no  
defect in any document in this  
affair which would invalidate  
the sale If he has paid the  
Taxes for those years it will  
be seen by reference to the ~~and the~~  
Collectors Ralls of which I have  
no copy
