To the Municipal Council of Westmouth

The Petition of John Crawford

humbly sheweth - that your petitioner, is called upon to pay, 29 dollars of back taxes for the years 1858-1859, before the property came into his possession - of which claim on the property he knew not at the time he purchased it.

And the prayer of your petitioner is, that you will, if possible, remit the aforesaid back-tax - or if that cannot be done, that you will be pleased to allow that amount to be expended on the blank line on the west of the Westmouth Lake - so that he may have a chance of doing the work instead of paying the money.
