

Know all men by these presents, that we, Thomas Warrock, Thomas Lygze and George Justice all of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, in the Province of Canada, are severally bound unto the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County and Province aforesaid, in manner following, that is to say:— The said Thomas Warrock in the sum of forty dollars, the said Thomas Lygze in the sum of twenty dollars, and the said George Justice in the sum of twenty dollars, lawful money of Canada, for which payment well and truly to be made, we severally, and not each for the other, bind ourselves, and each of us binds himself, our, and each of our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated the twenty-fifth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.

Now the Condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bounden Thomas Warrock, shall from time to time, and at all times hereafter, faithfully perform the duties devolving upon him as a Tavern Keeper in the said Township of Westmeath, and faithfully observe, and conform to the By-Laws of the said Municipality, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force, and virtue.
