

Know all men by these Presents, that we, James Behan, Newton Eggleston and James Nelson, all of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Down, in the Province of Canada, are severally bound unto the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County and Province aforesaid, in manner following, that is to say - The said James Behan in the sum of fifty dollars, The said Newton Eggleston in the sum of twenty-five dollars, and the said James Nelson in the sum of twenty-five dollars, lawful money of Canada, and for which payment well and truly to be made, we severally, and not each for the other, bind ourselves, and each of us binds himself, our and each of our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated the nineteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five,

Now the condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bounden James Behan shall from time to time, and at all times hereafter, faithfully perform the duties devolving upon him as a Tavernkeeper in the said Township of Westmeath, and faithfully observe and comply with the By-Laws of the said Municipality, and shall also finish and furnish his house, and build and finish his Stable and Shed, upon the premises where his Tavern is to be kept, according to the requirements of the By-Laws of the said Municipality, not later than the twentieth day of the month of October next, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
