Sealed with our seals and dated the _____ first _____ day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.

Now the condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bounden John Brown _____ shall from time to time, and at all times hereafter, faithfully perform

duties devolving upon him as a Tavern-keeper
in the said Township of Westmeath, and
faithfully perform and observe the By-Laws
of the said Municipality, Then this obligation
to be void, otherwise to be and remain in
