Bertrand in the sum of twenty dollars, and the said Loussaint Cecil in the sum of twenty dollars, lawful money of Canada, and for which payment well and truly to be made, we severally, and not each for the other, bind ourselves, and each of us binds himself, our and each of our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated the Twenty sixth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.

Now the condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bounden Eli Marcott - shall from time to time, and at all times hereafter, faithfully perform the duties devolving upon him as

a Tavern-keeper, in the said Township of
Westmeath, and faithfully perform, and
observe the By-Laws of the said Municipal-
ity, Then this obligation to be void, other-
wise to be and remain in full force and
virtue.
