

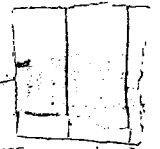

Sealed with our Seals and dated the \_\_\_\_\_ first \_\_\_\_\_ day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.

Now the condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bounden, Allan Mc Crackin shall from time to time, and at all times hereafter, faithfully perform the

duties devolving upon him as a Tavern-keeper in the said Township of Westmeath, and faithfully perform and observe the By-Laws of the said Municipality, Then this Obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.

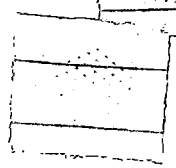
