

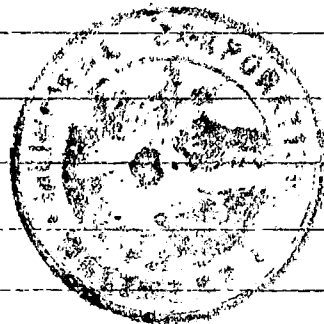
By-Law No. 2. - 1866

A By-Law to pay out certain sums of money therein mentioned, Whereas it is necessary to pay out the several sums of money herein after mentioned,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted by virtue of, and under the authority of the Act aforesaid, that, R. P. Smith be paid the sum of nine  $\frac{41}{100}$  dollars for work on Proof line between Lots 10 & 11 W. M. L. that the Trustees of School Section No. eleven be paid the sum of twelve  $\frac{76}{100}$  dollars, being School Rates on Absentee Lands, due said Section for the year 1865, and that J. C. Chamberlain be paid the sum of eight dollars for Costs paid Mulloy in the Case of Brown.
