

By-Law No. 3 - 1866

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned -

Whereas it is necessary to pay the

several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of

the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of,

and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled

"An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", and

it is hereby enacted by virtue of, and under the authority of the Act

aforesaid, that, Joseph Reyes be paid the sum of one hundred

and thirty-one $\frac{89}{100}$ dollars, for assessing, collecting and postage for

1865, Widow Fraser be paid six $\frac{42}{100}$ dollars, for taxes for '65

she is unable to pay, Widow Dougherty be paid four $\frac{20}{100}$ dollars

for taxes for 1865, she is unable to pay, John Collins be paid two

$\frac{47}{100}$ dollars for taxes for 1865, he is unable to pay, Joseph Reyes

Collector be paid thirty-three $\frac{64}{100}$ dollars for the purpose of

settling the Collector's Roll for the year 1865, and that

W. Cannon be paid two $\frac{19}{100}$ dollars for postage to date,

and that the sum of two dollars be paid to John Griffith

as Auditor for accounts of Township for 1864, and John

Bennie be paid the sum of two dollars as Auditor for the

year 1864
