therein mentioned.

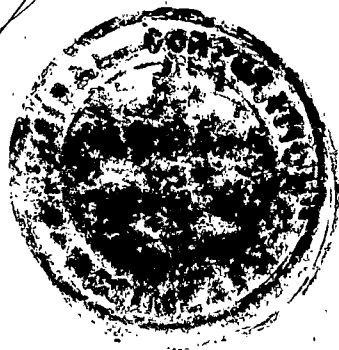
Whereas it is necessary to pay out the several
sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council
of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and
assembled by virtue, and under the authority,
of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled
"An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions
of Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted by
virtue, and under the authority, of the Act
aforesaid, that Chuvett & Co. be paid the sum of
four $\frac{56}{100}$ dollars for Rolls &c. that W. Cannon be paid the
sum of two dollars for Registry of Deed from Jas. Wilkie,
that Joseph Howard be paid the sum of two dollars for
Scraper, that Mr. Munroe, Millar, be paid the sum of
eight dollars for flour to La Croix, granted by the Council,
