

By-Law No. 7 - 1866 -

A By-Law to pay out certain sums of money therein mentioned -

Whereas it is necessary to pay out the several sums of money herein after mentioned,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of An Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted by the virtue and under the authority of the same, that Mr James Poole, be paid the sum of twelve <sup>75</sup>/<sub>100</sub> dollars for Printing, - and that Matthew M<sup>c</sup> Laren be paid the sum of ten dollars for road work.
