

By-Law No. 9 - 1866.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned,

Whereas, it is necessary to pay the several sums of money herein after mentioned,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted by virtue, and under the authority of the same, that

- S.S. No. 1. The Trustees of School Section No. 1. be paid the sum of one hundred and seventy $\frac{76}{100}$ dollars, the Trustees of School Section No. 2. the sum of two hundred and ten $\frac{54}{100}$ dollars -
- S.S. No. 3. The Trustees of School Section ^{No. 3} be paid one hundred and fifty -
- S.S. No. 5. nine $\frac{95}{100}$ dollars - the Trustees of School Section No. 5, two hundred and nineteen $\frac{85}{100}$ dollars - The Trustees of School Section No. 6. one hundred and fifty $\frac{26}{100}$ dollars - The Trustees of School Section No. 7. two hundred and twenty -
- S.S. 8. five $\frac{24}{100}$ dollars - The Trustees of School Section No. 8. one hundred and twenty-five $\frac{25}{100}$ dollars - The Trustees of School Section No. 9. one hundred $\frac{22}{100}$ dollars - the Trustees of School Section No. 10. one hundred and five $\frac{12}{100}$ dollars -
- S.S. No. 11. The Trustees of School Section No. 11. eighty-one $\frac{38}{100}$ dollars - that the sum of ten dollars be paid to Patrick Mc-Cashay, that each Member of Council be paid the sum of ten dollars, that twelve dollars be paid to Martin Lebow, that one $\frac{8}{100}$ dollars be paid Chewett & Co, that Thomas Fraser be paid the sum of two hundred dollars, that twenty dollars be paid to Duncan Mc-Coy, that ten dollars be paid to Robert Mc-Lellan, that Joseph Labine be paid nine dollars, that Thomas Wright be paid seven and one half dollars, that Maxim Dupuis be paid seven and one half dollars, that Widow Little be paid the

sum of seven $\frac{90}{100}$ dollars, that Thomas M. Carswell be paid the sum of three $\frac{60}{100}$ dollars, and that W. Cannon be paid the sum of one hundred and seven $\frac{59}{100}$ dollars, and that J. C. Chamberlain be paid the sum of fifty dollars.
