

By-Law No. 10. 1866

A By-Law to appoint the place of holding the Elections for the Township of Westmeath.

Whereas it is necessary to appoint a place for holding Elections in the Township of Westmeath, Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted by virtue and under the authority of the same, that the Townhall, in the village of Beachburg in the said Township of Westmeath be the place in which to hold all Elections for the said Township.
