

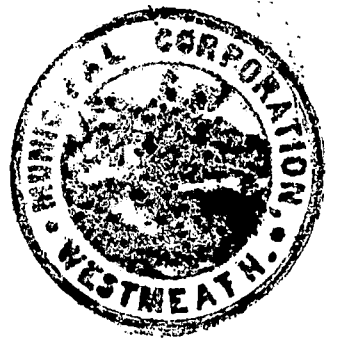
By-Law No. 1. — 1867.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas, it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, — constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada and it is hereby enacted by virtue, and under the authority of the same, that, James Swin be paid the sum of two dollars for ~~work~~ fire work, that the Trustees of School Section No. 4, be paid the sum of three  $\frac{93}{100}$  dollars, that Henry Brownly be paid the sum of five dollars that William Hughes be paid the sum of two and one half dollars, that Wynnan Christie be paid the sum of three  $\frac{15}{100}$  dollars, and that Alexander Condie be paid the sum of thirty-five dollars
