

By-Law No. 4. — 1867

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas, it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted by and under the authority of the same, that Mrs W. Russell be paid the sum of two dollars, that William Russell be paid the sum of five dollars, that Joseph Keyes be paid sixteen $\frac{50}{100}$ dollars, and that Timothy Buchanan be paid the sum of sixty dollars
