

By-Law No. 8 - 1867.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money -

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Dufferin, by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted, by and under the authority of the same that, So be it

Wigelsworth be paid the sum of seven dollars, that

J. M. Carswell be paid the sum of ten dollars, that

James Dickson be paid the sum of two dollars, that

James Moran be paid two dollars for Statute Labour performed, that Michael Archambault, James Collins, James Harper, George Larkins, Robert Mc Gregor, Daniel Brown,

Daniel Shaw, Michael Tully, William Watson, Henry White, James Ross, and Henry O'Brien be paid, each,

the sum of two dollars for Statute Labour performed, that Joseph Reyes, Collector, be paid one $\frac{50}{100}$ dollars for

Burke's Taxes, three $\frac{07}{100}$ dollars for B. Warren's Taxes -

eighty-five cents for Mrs Docherty's Taxes unable to collect for 1866, and that Joseph Reyes be paid

the sum of one hundred and forty-eight $\frac{15}{100}$ dollars,

for Salary as Assessor for '67. Collector for '66, collector of School Rates &c &c
