

By Law No. 9 — 1867.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain moneys,  
Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of  
money hereinafter mentioned, and now due by the Municipal  
Corporation of the Township of Westmeath.

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal  
Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of  
Punfrow, constituted and assembled by virtue, and  
under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of  
Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal  
Institutions of Upper Canada", and it is hereby en-  
acted by virtue, and under the authority of the same,

A Brown \$60<sup>00</sup> that Augustus Brown be paid the sum of  
sixty dollars, and that William Cannon  
be paid (\$3-93) three  $\frac{93}{100}$  dollars for Postage  
& Stationery.
