

By-Law No-10-1867.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money herein after mentioned,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, an "Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted by virtue, and under the authority of the same, that Chewett & Co

be paid the sum of six $\frac{94}{100}$ dollars, for acct. to date, that Abel Beach be paid three dollars, for Auditing accts. of 1866. that Joseph Beach be paid eight dollars from the dog fund, that John Brown be paid fifty-two dollars, and that Patrick Mc-Cagerty be paid one dollar for road work.
