

By-Law No. 11 — 1867.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money mentioned therein.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted by virtue, and under the authority of the same that, ~~John~~^{Suggestus} Brown be paid the sum of \$92.⁶⁰/₁₀₀ for Building Bridges & for Cedar timber, and that Alex. Condie be paid the sum of thirty-nine dollars for timber for Beachburg Bridge.
