

By-Law No. 14 in 1867.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money herein mentioned,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted by virtue, and under the authority of the same, that

J. Collins  $\$20\frac{2}{3}$  James Collins, be paid the sum of Twenty dollars, that  
W. Wright  $12\frac{2}{3}$  William Wright be paid the sum of Twelve  $\frac{2}{3}$  dollars,  
J. Ward  $\$8\frac{2}{3}$  John Ward be paid the sum of Eight dollars, and  
that Robert Angus be paid the sum of twenty dollars.
