

By Law No. 17 — 1867.

A By-Law to amend the fifteenth Clause of By-Law No. six<sup>1867</sup>, intituled, "a By-Law respecting the running at large of certain Animals, the Height of Lawful fences, fine viewers &c &c".

Whereas it is expedient to amend the fifteenth Clause of By-Law No. Six, 1867, abovementioned, <sup>in so far as</sup> to permit the Council of the Township to return to the party or parties entitled to receive the same, any surplus which may have been paid to the Township Treasurer under the provision of the above recited By-Law, notwithstanding ~~that the same~~ was not claimed by such party or parties within the term of three months from the Sale,

Wherefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue and under the authority of An Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal institutions of Upper Canada" and it is hereby enacted by virtue and under the authority of the same, that the said Municipal Council may return to the ~~original~~ owner of any animal sold under the provisions of the abovementioned By-Law No. six-1867, or other party entitled to claim the same, any surplus which may have been paid to the Township Treasurer, from any sale by Pound ~~keepers~~ within the said Township, notwithstanding that such surplus may not have been claimed by the owner or such other party entitled to receive the same within the said term of three months from the time of sale, upon satisfactory evidence, or other statement to the satisfaction of the Council aforesaid, that the ~~original~~ owner of such animal or animals, or other party claiming by or under him or her, ~~and entitled~~ to such surplus, is really and truly entitled to <sup>receive</sup> such surplus, grant an Order, for the Township Treasurer to pay such surplus to the party named in such order.
