

By-Law No. 18 — 1867.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money,
therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of
money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the
Township of Westmeath, in the County of Dufferin, ^{and assembled} constituted, by virtue
and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada
intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of
Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted by virtue and
under the authority of the said Act, that, Hugh Hayes be

paid the sum of nine $\frac{50}{100}$ dollars, that James Johnston
be paid the sum of one dollar, that Joseph Hayes be
paid the sum of eighty five dollars, that Thomas
Collins be paid fifty dollars, that Robert Angus be
paid the sum of eight $\frac{40}{100}$ dollars, that David Brown
be paid the sum of two dollars, that Samuel Wright
be paid the sum of five dollars, and that Robert

Byham be paid thirty $\frac{40}{100}$ dollars.
