

By-Law No. 19 — 1867.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of the several sums of money therein mentioned —

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted by virtue, and under the authority of the said Act, that

School Section No. 1 — the Trustees of School Section No. 1. be paid the sum of one hundred and ninety five  $\frac{700}{100}$  dollars, that the Trustees of School Section No. 2. be paid the sum of two hundred and fifty  $\frac{83}{100}$  dollars, that <sup>the Trustees of</sup> School Section No. 3. be paid the sum of two hundred  $\frac{40}{100}$  dollars, that the Trustees of School Section No. 4. be paid the sum of one hundred and eight  $\frac{08}{100}$  dollars, that the Trustees of School Section No. 5. be paid the sum of two hundred  $\frac{50}{100}$  dollars, that the Trustees of School Section No. 6. be paid the sum of two hundred and fifty four  $\frac{87}{100}$  dollars, that the Trustees of School Section No. 7. be paid the sum of two hundred  $\frac{48}{100}$  dollars, that the Trustees of School Section No. 8. be paid the sum of one hundred and twenty  $\frac{60}{100}$  dollars, that the Trustees of School Section No. 9. be paid the sum of one hundred and twenty  $\frac{13}{100}$  dollars, that the Trustees of School Section No. 10. be paid the sum of Sixty  $\frac{16}{100}$  dollars, that the Trustees of School Section No. 11. be paid the sum of Ninety nine  $\frac{97}{100}$  dollars, that J.W. Walker be paid twenty nine  $\frac{64}{100}$  dollars, that Messrs. Chewitt & Co. be paid two  $\frac{79}{100}$  dollars, that William Russell be paid eight dollars, that James Porteous be paid thirty dollars, that Robert M<sup>c</sup> Lelland be paid twenty six  $\frac{25}{100}$  dollars, that Cyrille Gervais be paid thirty two  $\frac{60}{100}$  dollars, that the Reeve and Councillors be paid

the sum of twelve dollars each; that John C. Collins  
be exempt from the price of two Barrels Flour due to Council,  
that, W. Bell, Surveyor be paid fifteen dollars, that  
W. Cannon be paid one hundred and thirteen  $\frac{53}{100}$  Dollars,  
that J. C. Chamberlain be paid fifty dollars, that  
J. C. Chamberlain be paid thirty one  $\frac{25}{100}$  dollars  
for Court expenses &c. that Henry Bromley be  
paid six  $\frac{50}{100}$  dollars for Shup Killed, that James  
Ormsby be paid \$4.50 = four dollars and fifty cents,  
that Thomas Mathieson be paid three  $\frac{50}{100}$  dollars
