

By-Law No. 1868

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas, it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, ^{being enacted by} the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled an "Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada" and it is hereby enacted by virtue, and under the authority of the same, that Charles Patterson be paid the sum

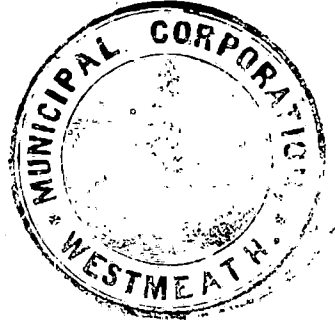
