

By-Law No. 3 — 1868

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

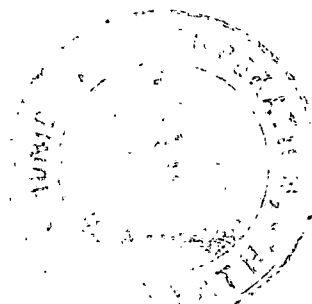
Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted, by virtue, and under the authority of the said Act, that Duncan Mc Laren ~~and~~ Cameron and Mathew Mc Laren be paid the sum of fifty eight dollars, that John Griffiths be paid ^{six dollars} for Auditing ~~for~~ the Accounts of '66-'67 and that John Griffiths Mathew Stevenson be paid three dollars for Auditing Accounts for the year 1867. That Joseph Keyes be ~~paid~~ allowed by Township Treasurer \$6.00 for L. Grattan, Charles Mc Ginnis \$3.00, Frances Ritchie \$2.00 and for Joseph Weldon for \$8.16 to enable him to settle with the Township Treasurer for the Collector's Roll for 1867. That W. Cannon be paid \$1.79 for Postage to date and that Joseph Keyes be paid the sum of one hundred and forty two $\frac{52}{100}$ dollars.
