

By-Law No. 4 - 1868

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an act of the Parliament of Canada, — entitled an "Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted by virtue and under the authority of the same, that, Damasse

\$100⁰⁰ Servais be paid the sum of one hundred dollars, that

\$5⁰⁰ John Chambers be paid the sum of five ~~20~~ dollars, from

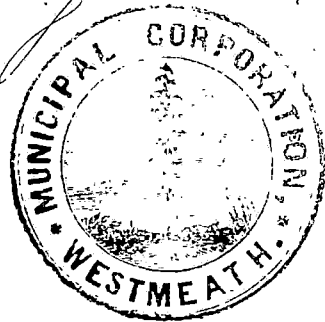
\$5⁰⁰ the dog fund, ^{and} that John O'Brien be paid the sum of five dollars from the dog fund,
