

By-Law No. 5 — 1869,

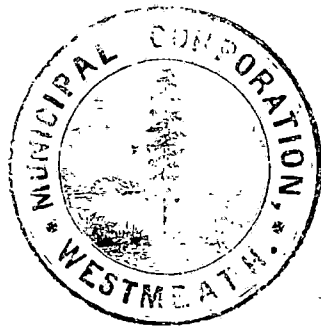
A By-Law to authorize the payment of money,

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money herein after mentioned,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted by virtue, and under the authority of the same, that Duncan McLaren be paid four dollars, that John Little Sen. be paid twelve $\frac{50}{100}$ dollars, that W. Cannon be paid one $\frac{53}{100}$ dollars, that W. Duck be paid the sum of two dollars, and that Joseph Reyes be paid the sum of one hundred and ~~thirty~~ ^{forty} one dollars.
