

By-Law No. 6 - 1869

A By-Law to amend By-Law No. 2 - 1869.

Whereas by By-Law No. 2 - 1869, Robert M^c Cracken was appointed Pathmaster for the 4th Road Division, while he belongs to the 1st Road Division, and it is therefore necessary to appoint another person Pathmaster for the said 4th Road Division; and whereas a Pound Keeper is required on the Gore Line, and it is expedient to appoint such Pound Keeper, and also as John Thompson has been objected to as Pathmaster that another be appointed in his place.

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted by virtue, and under the authority of the same, that Mathew M^c Laren be Pathmaster for the fourth road division in place of Robert M^c Cracken, that William ^{Baird} be ~~Pathmaster~~ Pound Keeper, that Edward England be Pathmaster for the third road division in place of John Thompson, and that, that part of the clause in said By-Law No. 2 - 1869, appointing the said John Thompson and Robert M^c Cracken, Pathmaster for the third and fourth road divisions respectively be and is hereby repealed.
