

By-Law No-13-1869.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money mentioned therein.

Whereas, it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

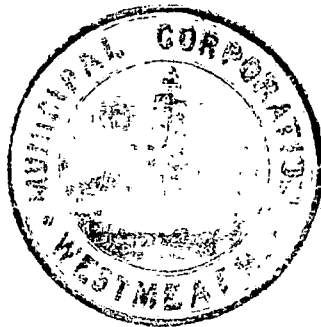
Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by, and under, the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", enacts as follows - viz: -

That J. M. Carswell be paid for Insurance on Townhall, six  $\frac{100}{100}$  dollars, that W. Beull be paid six  $\frac{25}{100}$  dollars for one Bbl. Flour to Charles Johnston, that Wm Russell be paid for scrubbing Townhall, two dollars, and that Robert Graham, Sen, be paid thirty two dollars for tending bridges on Muskrot.

Passed in open Council the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October 1869.
