

By-Law No. 1. - 1870

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned,

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, the Council of the Municipality of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," enacts as follows, viz: - that Timothy Buchanan be paid thirty five dollars, that James Dunn be paid two dollars and fifty Cents, ^{and} that Mrs. Russell be paid the sum of two dollars.
