

By-Law, No. 3. — 1870

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money.

Whereas, it is necessary to pay the several sums of money herein-after mentioned,

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled, by virtue, and under the authority, of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", enacts as follows, viz —

That James Wilson be paid the sum of Fifteen Dollars,

That the Rev^d Mr. Simpson, Beachburgh, be refunded the sum of five $\frac{7}{100}$ Dollars for Taxes paid by him in the year 1869 on his premises.

That the Trustees of School Section No. 2, be paid the sum of Nineteen $\frac{93}{100}$ Dollars for Non-resident ^{Taxes or} Rates for 1869.

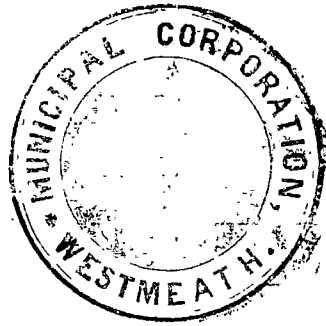
