

By Law No. 4. A. D. 1870.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority, of An Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", enacts as follows, viz:—

That John Johnston be paid the sum of One dollar.

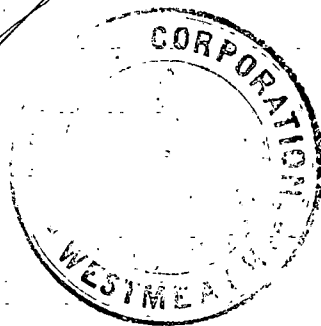
That George Swetes be paid the sum of Six Dollars, and that Joseph Reyes be paid the sum of one hundred and Sixty two dollars and forty seven Cents.
