

By-Law No-5-1870

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada, enacts as follows, viz-

That, Timothy Buchanan be paid forty five dollars, that Robert Stewart be paid twenty four dollars, that Patrick Mc-Casherty be paid nineteen dollars, ^{and} that John Hannah be paid two dollars
