

By-Law No. 6. 1870.

A By-Law to authorize the Levy and Collection of certain sums of Money, or Rates, mentioned therein.

Whereas, it is necessary to Levy and collect upon all the rateable property within the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, the several hereinafter mentioned sums of Money for the purposes following viz - The Sum of Seven hundred and seventy dollars for County purposes, the sum of three hundred and eight dollars for Interest on County securities and Sinking Fund, the sum of three hundred and forty nine dollars for General School Fund, and the sum of four hundred and seventy eight dollars for the Township purposes.

And whereas the Trustees of the undermentioned School Sections within the said Township of Westmeath, have, by Petition prayed this Council, to levy and collect upon all the rateable property within their several School Sections, for Special School purposes, the several hereinafter mentioned sums of money, viz - In School Section No. 1. the sum of one hundred and ten dollars - In School Section No. 2. the sum of Four hundred and thirty dollars - In School Section No. 3. the sum of Two hundred Dollars -

In School Section No. 4. the sum of Eighty Dollars -

In School Section No. 5 the sum of One hundred and eighty dollars, In School Section No. 6 the sum of One hundred and forty dollars - In School Section No. 7 the sum of One hundred and eighty dollars - in School Section No. 8 the sum of One hundred and forty Dollars -

In School Section No. 9 the sum of One hundred Dollars -

In School Section No. 10 the sum of One hundred and eighty dollars - and in School Section No. 11 the sum of One hundred and twenty dollars, and whereas it is expedient to comply with the prayers of the said Petitioners,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority, of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, An Act respec

respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada" and it is hereby enacted by virtue, and under the authority of the same, That the Collector for the Township of Westmeath for the present year, shall levy and collect, and such Collector is hereby authorized and required to levy and collect, upon all the rateable property within the Township of Westmeath aforesaid the several rates hereinafter mentioned for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned; And such Collector is also hereby authorized and required to levy and collect upon all the rateable property within the several School Sections aforesaid the herein-mentioned Special School Rates. That is to say —

A Rate of $5\frac{43}{100}$ Mills (Five $43/100$ Mills) in the Dollar for County purposes.

A Rate of Two $18/100$ Mills in the Dollar for County Debentures and Sinking Fund.

A Rate of Two $47/100$ Mills in the Dollar for a General School Fund.

A Rate of Three $37/100$ Mills in the Dollar for Township purposes.

A Rate of Seven $9/10$ Mills in the Dollar for a Special School Rate in School Section No. 1.

A Rate of Nineteen $9/10$ Mills in the Dollar for a Special School Rate in School Section No. 2.

A Rate of Thirteen Mills — in the Dollar for a Special School Rate in School Section No. 3.

A Rate of Ten 10 Mills — in the Dollar for a Special School Rate in School Section No. 4.

A Rate of Ten $6/10$ Mills in the Dollar for a Special School Rate in School Section No. 5.

A Rate of Fourteen $2/10$ Mills in the Dollar for a Special School Rate in School Section No. 6.

A Rate of Five $9/10$ Mills in the Dollar for a Special School Rate in School Section No. 7.

A Rate of Twenty one $7/10$ Mills in the Dollar for a Special School Rate in School Section No. 8.

A Rate of Fifteen Mills — in the Dollar for a Special School Rate in School Section No. 9.

A Rate of Twenty Nine Mills in the Dollar for a Special

School Rate in School Section No. 10.

And A Rate of Three Cents in the Dollar for a Special School
