

By Law No - 9 - 1870

A By Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money herein after mentioned,

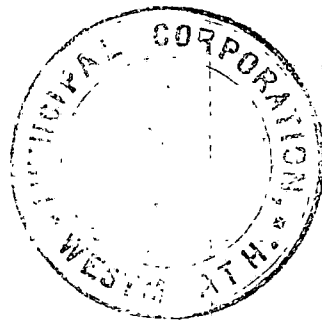
Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority, of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," enacts as follows, that is to say:—

That the sum of Ten Dollars be paid to Patrick M^cCahey, that Thomas Ross be paid the sum of Ten dollars, that Patrick Shannon be paid the sum of Twenty nine dollars, that Henry White be paid the sum of five ⁴⁰/₁₀₀ dollars, that Robert Graham be paid the sum of Thirty two dollars, that John Anderson be paid the sum of five ²⁵/₁₀₀ Cents, that Joseph Beach be paid the sum of four dollars, ~~that~~ that the Victoria Insurance Company be paid the sum of four ²⁰/₁₀₀ dollars, that Donald M^cLean be paid the sum of thirty dollars, that James M^cLean be paid the sum of twenty five ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ dollars, that Theophil Gervais be paid the sum of Twenty one dollars, and that John Visereau be paid the sum of Thirty Dollars. that Baptiste Gervais be paid the sum of Twenty five Dollars, and that Thomas Deacon be paid the sum of Two dollars.

Passed in open Council the 29th day of October 1870.
