

By-Law No. 10 — 1870.

A By-Law to alter the boundaries of certain School Sections in the Township of Westmeath.

Whereas, applications have been made to this Council, to alter the boundaries of certain School Sections in the Township of Westmeath, and the Trustees of the several School Sections — interested, have been duly notified of the proposed alterations, ~~and~~ have made no objection thereto; And Whereas, it is right and proper that such alterations be made, ~~by vesting the same in the~~

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue and under the authority, of an Act of the Parliament of Canada intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," enacts as follows:—

That Lots number Eight in the third Concession E.M.L. and the South East quarter of Lot number One in the fourth Concession E.M.L. be detached from School Section number Seven and attached to School Section number Ten.

That the whole of the Sixth Concession, excepting Lot number Thirteen and the West half of Lot number fourteen be detached from School Section Number five and attached to School Section Number four.

And that Lots Numbers Ten and the West half of Nine in the fourth Concession, C.L.F. be detached from School Section number Three and attached to School Section number Two.
