

By-Law No 11 A D 1873

A By-Law to authorize the Trustees of School Section No 7 of the Township of Westmeath in the Village of Beachburgh, to borrow money to pay for the erection of a School House in said Section

Whereas the Trustees of the above mentioned School Section have presented to this Council a Petition praying for authority to borrow the sum of sixteen hundred dollars for the use of the said Section and whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioners

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada entitled an Act respecting Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada, enacts as follows that is to say that George Sirtes, Alexander Condie and Georges Forbes M.P. Trustees of School Section No Seven in the Township of Westmeath be and are hereby authorized to borrow the sum of sixteen hundred dollars for the purpose of paying for the erection of a School House in said School Section, and on condition that the said sum of sixteen hundred dollars be paid with all interest accrued thereon ten years from the last day of December next A.D. 1873 to be levied and collected by the Township Collector in the manner following that is one hundred and sixty dollars and interest thereon when the Township

Taxes are Collected and one hundred and fifty dollars an Interest on each and every year until the whole amount of the debt is discharged
