

By-Law No 2. 1874

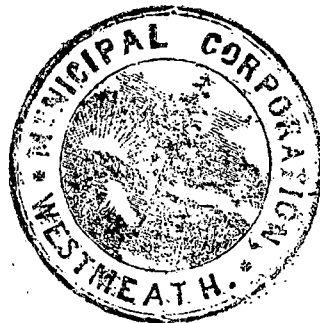
A By-Law to extend the time for the Township Collector to collect the Township Taxes

Whereas it is necessary to extend the time for collecting the Township Taxes for the year 1873,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew constituted and assembled by virtue and under the authority of an act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada" enacts as follows - that is to say, That the Township Collector, Joseph Keyes be allowed until the first day of March now next ensuing the date of this By-Law to collect the Township Taxes for the year 1873.
