

By-Law No. 3 1874.

A By-Law, to repeal a By-Law made and passed by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew for prohibiting the sale of Intoxicating Liquors in Shops and Houses of Public Entertainment within the said Township of Westmeath and numbered 2 - 1873.

Whereas, several Petitions praying for the repeal of the said By-Law numbered 2 - 1873 have been presented to, and accepted by, the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath, at its sitting held in the Townhall this nineteenth day of January, A.D. 1874.

And whereas, at the said sitting, the said Municipal Council did appoint the twenty first day of February, A.D. 1874, at the hour of nine o'clock in the forenoon, for the purpose of taking the votes of the Electors of the said Township for and against this By-Law and did order a Poll to be held at the Townhall in the said Township, at the day and hour above mentioned, for taking and recording such votes, and did name William Cannon Returning Officer at said Poll: And whereas, a copy of this By-Law and of a notice of the intention of this Council to take into consideration and to pass this By-Law (after one month from the first publication thereof) has been duly published in the Pembroke Observer Newspaper, for three weeks previous to the said twenty first day of February, A.D. 1874, and four such copies have been duly posted up in four of the most public places within the said Township: And whereas, such Poll has been duly opened and held at the said time and place, and by the Poll Book used, and duly sworn to, at such Poll, it does appear that a majority of the Electors of the said Township did, by their votes so taken, approve of this By-Law:

Therefore the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled, by virtue and under the authority, of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", enacts as follows, that is to say: - That the By-Law for prohibiting the sale of Intoxicating Liquors in Shops and Houses of Public Entertainment within the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew and numbered 2 - 1873, be and is hereby repealed.
