

By-Law No. 4. — 1874

A By-Law to amend By-Law No. 14-1873, intituled, "a By-Law to authorize the Trustees of School Section number seven in the Township of Westmeath to borrow the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the erection of a School-House at the Village of Beachburg within the said Section";

Whereas several clerical errors have been made in the above mentioned By-Law No. 14-1873; and it is necessary that such errors shall be corrected without any delay,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", enacts as follows, viz —

That wheresoever in the said By-Law No. 14-1873, the words "Two hundred and forty four Dollars," and "70 Mills in the Dollar," do occur, the said above quoted words shall be erased from said By-Law No. 14-1873. and the words, two hundred and forty eight, and nine six tenths Mills in the dollar, be inserted instead thereof, and the said above mentioned words shall be read in place of the above quoted words, and shall be considered and be taken as the true intent and meaning of the said By-Law No. 14-1873. And that the clause following shall be added to the said By-Law No. 14-1873, and be read and deemed and taken as part of the aforesaid By-Law No. 14-1873. viz —

That it shall be law full for the Reeve of the said Municipality to cause two ^{to be prepared, and made payable} ~~securities~~ (or other obligation to pay) to the Trustees of said Section, or order, or bearer; one of each securities or other obligation to pay for the sum of One thousand dollars ^{principal} and five hundred and fifty dollars for Interest thereon, amounting ^{together} to the sum of fifteen hundred and fifty dollars, which said sum is to be paid in equal annual payments of one hundred

and fifty five dollars, lawful money of Canada, in each and every year, on the thirty first day of December, for the term of ten years, until the said principal sum and interest be fully paid, and the other of such said debentures or other obligation to pay, for the sum of six hundred dollars, principal, and three hundred and thirty dollars for interest thereon, amounting to the sum of nine hundred and thirty dollars, which said sum is to be paid in equal annual payments of ninety three dollars, lawful money of Canada, in each and every year, on the thirty first day of December, for the term of ten years, until the said principal sum and interest be fully paid, the first payments of said yearly instalments, above mentioned, to be made and paid on the thirty first day of December in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and seventy four.
