

By-Law No. 6 - 1874.

A By-Law, to extend the time for collecting the Taxes of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1873.

Whereas in consequence of the stagnation of trade, the Collector for this Township has hitherto been unable to collect the Taxes in full for the said Township for the year 1873, and has requested an extension of time for collection of the same, And Whereas it is expedient to grant a further extension of time to collect said Taxes,

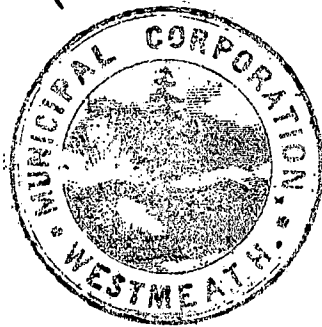
Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority, of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, intituled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," enacts as follows. viz -

allowed until the first day of April next to collect
such taxes.
