

By-Law No. 7. 1874

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money mentioned therein.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue, and under the authority, of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", enacts as follows. viz -

That James Findlay be paid the sum of four dollars and seventy five cents (\$4.75).

That Augustus Brown be paid the sum of two dollars and twenty five cents.

That Thomas Thwaites be paid the sum of one dollar and fifty cents.

That James Dickson be paid the sum of eighteen dollars and ninety five cents and George Tucker be paid

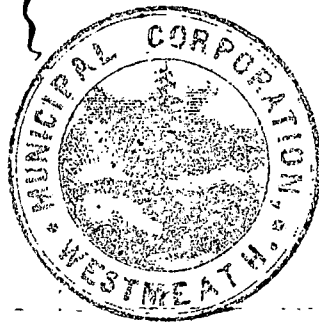
the sum ten dollars and fifty cents.
