

By-Law No. 16-1874

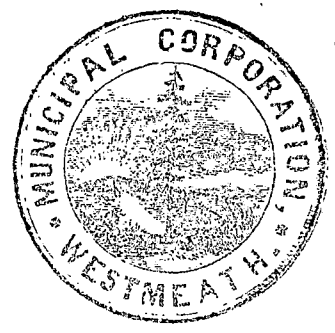
A. By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Town of Westmeath in the County of Kildare, pursuant to the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, passed in the thirty sixth year of Her Majesty's Reign, Chaptered Forty eight, enacts as follows, that is to say:-

- Jos Collins. That Joseph Collins be paid the sum of forty Dollars,
- J. Cecil. That Louisant Cecil be paid one hundred & twenty five Dollars.
- J. Devine. That Samuel Devine be paid Forty Dollars, in part payment.
- W. Cannon. That W. Cannon be paid two and one half Dollars,
- Jos. Dupuis. That Joseph Dupuis be paid fifty Dollars
- Infirmary. That the Superintendent of the Eye & Ear Infirmary be paid twenty-one ^{49/100} Dollars on acct of Patrick Broughen.
- G. Cowdry. That George Cowdry be paid the sum of ^{Forty} nine Dollars, (\$49.00);
- J. Burgess. That Thomas Burgess be paid the sum of eighteen Dollars and
- Aug Brown. That Augustus Brown be paid the sum of two hundred and seventy-five dollars
