

By-Law No. 17 — 1874.

A By-Law to repeal By-Law Number 18, A.S. 1873, intituled,
"By-Law No. 18, A.S. 1873, to authorize the Trustees of School Section
Number Two of the Township of Westmeath to borrow the sum of Three
hundred Dollars for the erection of an addition to their School House
at the Village of Front Westmeath within the said School Section".

Whereas the Trustees of the said School Section Number Two of the
Township of Westmeath aforesaid, have made a written application to this
Council for the repeal of the above quoted By-Law, stating in the said
application that they have placed in their estimate of School expenses for the
present year a sum sufficient to make the necessary addition to their
School House in addition to the other expenses of their school for the
present year, and will not in consequence, require to raise money under
the said above quoted By-Law, and in the said application request that
the By-Law above mentioned may therefore be repealed,

And whereas it is expedient to comply with the request contained and
expressed in the said application of the Trustees of the said School Section,

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath
aforesaid, by and under an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, intituled,
"An Act respecting Municipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario",
enacts as follows, that is to say —

That By-Law Number eighteen of A.S. 1873, above quoted,
be, and is hereby repealed.

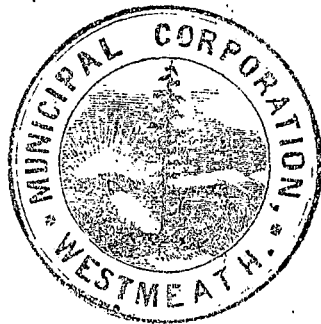
