

By-Law No. 2 - 1875

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money mentioned therein.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money herein after mentioned,

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, pursuant to an Act of the Legislature of Ontario passed in the 36th year of Her Majesty's Reign, and Chaptered 48, enacts as follows,

That H. R. Wilesworth be paid the sum of Thirty six Dollars.

That John Cowie be paid the sum of Four $\frac{50}{100}$ Dollars.

That Robert Eggleston be paid the sum of One $\frac{50}{100}$ Dollars.

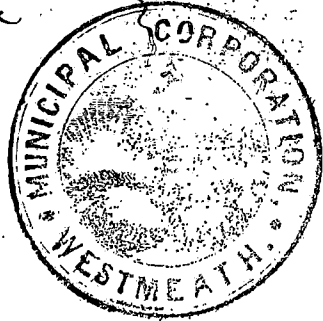
That W^m Virtue be paid the sum of Six $\frac{50}{100}$ Dollars; and

That W^m Cannon be paid the sum of Thirteen $\frac{40}{100}$ Dollars
