

By-Law No. 6. — 1875

A By-Law to Divide Road Division Number Three into two.

Whereas, John Robinson, Joseph Lafleur and several other Freeholders and Householders in the Township of Westmeath have applied by Petition to this Council to divide Road Division Number Three of the said Township into two parts,

And Whereas, it is expedient comply with the prayer of said Petition,

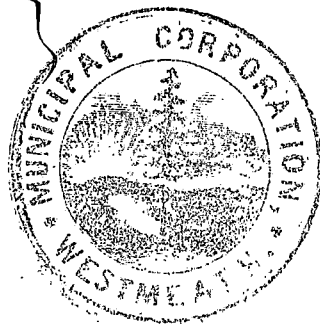
Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, pursuant to an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, intituled, "An Act respecting Municipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario", enacts as follows

That the said Road Division Number Three be divided into two parts, Lots Numbers 14, 15, 16, East $\frac{1}{2}$ of 17, East $\frac{1}{2}$ of 18, Lots ^{in Concession A, E. & D. L.} 19, 20 and 21 be and are hereby formed into a separate Division to be called the East half of ~~Lot~~ Road Division Number Three, and that the remaining Lots numbers West half of 17, West half of 18, East half of 19, Lots 20, 21, 22, 23 and the East halves of Lots numbers 24 and 25 all in Concession B, E & L be and are hereby formed into a separate Road Division to be called the West half of Road Division Number Three,

This By-Law shall take effect immediately upon and after the passing ~~of~~ of this By-Law thereof.

Passed in open Council the twentieth day of March A.D. 1875.
