

By-Law No. 10. — 1875

A By-Law to reduce the number of days' Statute Labour within the Township of Westmeath.

Whereas it is expedient to ~~to~~ reduce the number of days' Statute Labour, as fixed by the Legislature of Ontario, for persons rated on the Assessment Roll of the Township of Westmeath

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, pursuant to an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, intituled, "An Act respecting Municipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario," enacts as follows,

1. That every person assessed upon the Assessment Roll of the Township of Westmeath in respect of property, if his property is assessed at not more than \$500. shall be liable to two days' Statute Labour,

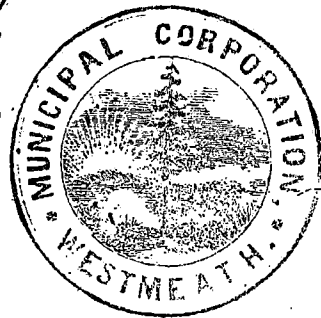

And for every \$1000 over \$3000, or any fractional part over \$500, one additional day.

2. That the foregoing scale of Statute Labour be used in the Township of Westmeath aforesaid in lieu of that furnished in the Statutes of the Province of Ontario, and that this By-Law have effect from and after the passing thereof.
