

By-Law No. 17 — 1875.

A By-Law to authorize the Levy and Collection of Rates to meet the Instalments payable on certain School Section Debentures, and also the Levy and Collection of certain Special School Rates for School Section purposes in the several School Sections in the Township of Westmeath for the year 1875.

Whereas it is necessary to levy and collect on all the rateable property in School Section No. 7, in the Township of Westmeath, the sum of Two hundred and forty-eight Dollars over and above all other Rates, for the purpose of paying the second Instalment of principal and Interest due on ~~two~~ Debentures issued under the authority of By-Law number Fourteen, 1873, and its amendment, By-Law number Four 1874, passed by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, which said Instalment is payable on the thirty first day of December next; And Whereas it is necessary to levy and collect on all the rateable property in School Section No. 5, in the said Township, the sum of Three hundred and thirty-one $\frac{35}{100}$ Dollars over and above all other Rates, for the purpose of paying the first instalment of principal and interest due on a Debenture issued under the authority of By-Law number Ten 1874, passed by the said Municipal Council, which said Instalment is payable on the thirty first day of December next; And Whereas it is necessary to levy and collect on all the rateable property in School Section No. 9, in the said Township, the sum of One hundred and eight Dollars over and above all other Rates, for the purpose of paying of the principal and interest due on a Debenture issued under the authority of By-Law number Eighteen 1874, passed by the said Council, which said Debenture is payable on the first day of January next; And Whereas the Trustees of the hereinafter mentioned School Sections within the said Township of Westmeath, have by their several petitions prayed this Council to levy and collect upon all the rateable property within their said several School Sections for Special School purposes in the said several School Sections the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned, viz:

Lt No. 1.	In School Section No. 1. Two hundred and Fifty Dollars. (\$ 250.00)
" " 2.	In School Section No. 2. Five hundred and fifty Dollars. (\$ 550.00)
" " 3.	In School Section No. 3. Two hundred and fifty Dollars. (\$ 250.00)
" " 4.	In School Section No. 4. One hundred and thirty Dollars. (\$ 130.00)
" " 5.	In School Section No. 5. Three hundred and fifty Dollars. (\$ 350.00)
" " 6.	In School Section No. 6. One hundred and seventy five Dollars. (\$ 175.00)
" " 7.	In School Section No. 7. Four hundred and seventy Dollars. (\$ 470.00)
" " 8.	In School Section No. 8. One hundred and eighty Dollars. (\$ 180.00)

- S. No. 10. In School Section No. 10. One hundred and twenty Dollars. (\$120.00)
 " " 11. And in School Section No. 11. Two hundred and fifty Dollars. (\$250.00)

And whereas it is necessary to comply with the prayers of the said Trustees,
 Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of
 Renfrew, pursuant to the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, passed in
 the thirty seventh year of Her Majesty's Reign, Chaptered 28. and intituled, "An Act
 to amend and consolidate the Public School Law," ^{as amended as follows} that is to say:—

That the Collector for the said Township of Westmeath, duly appointed for the current
 year, shall levy and collect, and such Collector is hereby required and authorized to levy
 and collect, upon all the rateable property within the several School Sections herein-
 after mentioned the several Taxes or Rates hereinafter mentioned for the several pur-
 poses hereinafter mentioned, and to pay the same over to the Treasurer of the said
 Township, That is to say:—

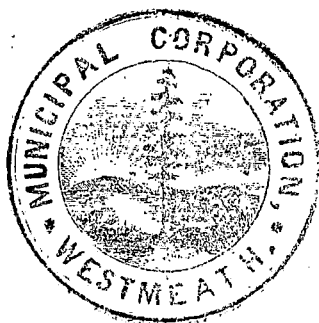
- S.S. No. 1. In School Section No. 7, a Rate of Three and $\frac{5}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar for the
 2nd Instalment of principal and interest on School Section Debentures.
 " " 5. In School Section No. 5, a Rate of Six Mills in the Dollar for the 1st
 Instalment of principal and interest on School Section Debenture.
 " " 9. In School Section No. 9, a Rate of Five Mills in the Dollar to discharge
 the principal and interest on School Section Debenture.

And for Special School purposes in the School Sections following, viz:—

- " " 1. In School Section No. 1. a Rate of Six $\frac{4}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar.
 " " 2. In School Section No. 2, a Rate of Seven $\frac{7}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar.
 " " 3. In School Section No. 3, a Rate of Five $\frac{7}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar.
 " " 4. In School Section No. 4, a Rate of Five $\frac{3}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar.
 " " 5. In School Section No. 5, a Rate of Six $\frac{7}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar.
 " " 6. In School Section No. 6, a Rate of Five Mills in the Dollar.
 " " 7. In School Section No. 7, a Rate of Seven Mills in the Dollar.
 " " 8. In School Section No. 8, a Rate of Eight $\frac{1}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar.
 " " 10. In School Section No. 10, a Rate of Six $\frac{5}{10}$ Mills in the Dollar, and
 " " 11. In School Section No. 11, a Rate of Fifteen Mills in the Dollar.

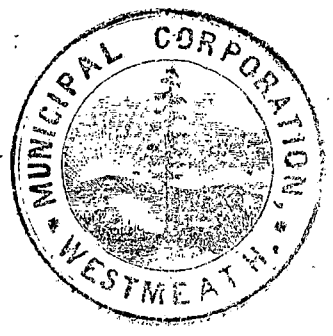
