

By-Law No. 18-1875

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, under the authority of an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, intituled, "an Act respecting the Municipal Institutions in the Province of Ontario," enacts as follows, viz:—

That, Henry Howard be paid the sum of Three ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars,

That John Collicis be paid the sum of Fifty Dollars,

That William C. Moore be paid the sum of Seventy-Seven Dollars,

That John Keyes be paid the sum of Sixty Dollars,

That Francis Rivais be paid the sum of Fifty Dollars,

That James Hawkins be paid the sum of Twenty Dollars,

That John Keyes be paid the sum of Ten Dollars,

That Augustus Brown be paid the sum of Sixty-nine ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars,

That Hiram Thrasher be paid the sum of Seventy Dollars,

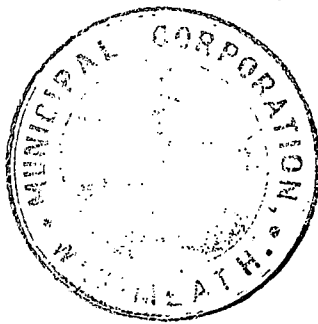
That Messrs M^cLaren & Mansell be paid the sum of Eight ^{Seven}/₁₀₀ Dollars

That Abraham Thrasher be paid the sum of Twenty-five Dollars and

That H. C. Jackson be paid the sum of Five Dollars.
