

By-Law No. 27 - 1875.

A By-Law to appoint Returning Officers for the Election of Reeve and Councillors for the Township of Westmeath for the year 1876 and to Establish Polling Places therefor.

Whereas it is necessary to appoint Three Returning Officers to take the Ballots at the approaching Election of a Reeve and Councillors for this Township, and to Establish Three Polling Places therein for holding the said Election

Therefore, The Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew, under the authority of an Act of the Legislature of Ontario, entitled, "An Act ^{respecting Municipal Institutions in the} ~~to provide for the holding of~~ ~~the~~ ~~Province of Ontario~~ ~~at the~~ ~~elections~~," enacts as follows, that is to say; -

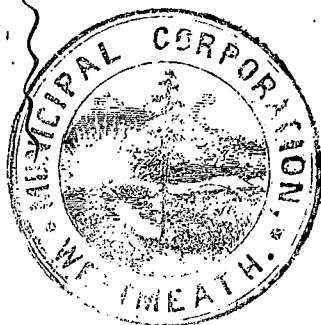
That Mr William Cannon of the said Township, -
Township Clerk; is hereby appointed Returning Officer, at the approaching Election of a Reeve and Councillors for the said Township of Westmeath, for the First Electoral Subdivision of the said Township, and that the Townhall, Beakburg, be the Polling Place in the said Subdivision.

That Mr ~~John Griffith~~ ^{H. W. Perri} of the said Township,
Teacher is hereby appointed Returning Officer at the said Election for the Second ^{Electoral} Subdivision of the said Township, and that the School House in School Section Number One of the said Township, known as Moore's School House, ^{said Subdivision,} be the Polling Place of the

That Mr. John Griffith of the said Township,
Teacher, is hereby appointed Returning Officer at the said Election for the Third Electoral Subdivision of the said Township, and that the School House in School Section Number Three of the said Township, known as Browleys' School House, be the Polling Place in the said Subdivision.
